

Frequently Asked Questions

Registration can be done online or by printing out a form and mailing it to our Anderson office. After requesting a class and submitting your registration, your card will be charged the first quarterly tuition and \$30 registration fee, once enrollment is confirmed. You will receive an email confirmation once placement is confirmed, along with a receipt. Registration fee is non-refundable, unless we cannot place your child in a class. The registration fee (\$30/family) and each student's first quarter tuition fees are due at registration.
When you register at Gotta Dance, we assume that you plan to participate in a full school year of classes and the Student Showcase in early June. Tuition is paid quarterly during the dance season. Quarterly payments are due upon registration, November 1, January 15 and March 15. All dues must be paid in full before the Student Showcase to receive costumes and/or tickets. Tuition payments will be fully refunded if we cannot accommodate your schedule requirements.
Cash, check or credit card payments are all acceptable. Automatic billing is an option. When you register, if you would like to have recurring billing, there is a box you must click for automatic payments to be withdrawn. If you do not wish to have automatic withdrawals quarterly, you may go online at any time to pay your bill.
The recital costume fee is \$50 per performance, due on November 1st. This may not be the only charge, depending on your child's class level. Beginning with the 4th Grade, students will usually perform in multiple numbers for the Student Showcase, requiring additional costumes, which will be charged to your account - all remaining balances will be due by January 15th. Costume fees and costumes are non-refundable once they are ordered – our costume vendors do not accept returns.
Costume expenses due Nov. 1:
3/4/5s & Kinder:
(1 costume) = \$50 total
1st/2nd Grades:
1hr,15 min. (2-in-1 costume) = \$60 total
3rd-5th Grades:
45 min. classes = \$50 deposit per class (any additional charges will be due in January)
All tuition payments are due on or before the due date. A late fee of \$25 will be assessed six days after the tuition due date. Thank you for your prompt payment and cooperation.

If you do need to withdraw from the studio during the season, we must receive a dated letter (no e-mails please) stating that you no longer plan to take classes as of the date of your student's last class. If we do not receive a letter, we assume that your child is still an active student and your tuition and fees will continue to accrue. We will refund tuition paid for any classes after receipt of the letter and the date of your child's last class. Tuition is not prorated. There are no refunds for missed classes.

If your student misses a class they are encouraged to take a make-up in an age/grade appropriate class. It is necessary to call in advance – due to class sizes, please let the us know that your child is coming for a makeup class. Please notify your teacher if your student will be absent for an extended period due to illness.

What is the dress code?

3 Year Olds:

Ballet - Black leotard (no skirts), pink footed or convertible tights, pink leather ballet (no strings preferred) and black tap shoes.

4 Year Olds - 2nd Graders:

Ballet - Black leotard (no skirts), pink footed tights (2nd and 3rd grades convertible tights are preferred), pink leather or canvas ballet shoes. *Tap* - black patent leather tap shoe (buckle or tie). *Jazz* shoes not necessary, any color leggings, leotard or form-fitting shirt. Hair in ponytail.

3rd - 6th Graders:

Ballet - Black leotard, pink tights (convertible preferred), pink leather or canvas ballet shoes (split sole preferred). Tap - Oxford black tap shoe (split sole or full sole). Jazz - Tan jazz shoes.

Hip Hop:

Proper dancewear. No jeans or shorts. Hair in ponytail.Black, clean non-marking Converse-style high top athletic shoes.
